amending Regulations (EEC) Nos. 3498/82 and 806/83 opening, allocating and providing for the administration of Community tariff quotas for sweet peppers and fresh table grapes, falling within subheadings 07.01 S and ex 08.04 A I of the Common Customs Tariff, originating in Cyprus (1983)

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

By Regulations (EEC) Nos. 3498/82 and 806/83 the Community opened Community tariff quotas at reduced duty rates for 250 tonnes of sweet peppers and 7 000 tonnes of fresh table grapes, falling within subheadings 07.01 S and ex 08.04 A I of the CCT, originating in Cyprus.

Regulation (EEC) No /83 laying down the arrangements applicable to trade with Cyprus provides for an increase of the abovementioned quota volumes as from 1 July 1983.

Consequently, Regulations (EEC) Nos. 3498/82 and 806/83 have to be amended.

COUNCIL REGULATION (EEC)

amending Regulations (EEC) Nos. 3498/82 and 806/83 opening, allocating and providing for the administration of Community tariff quotas for sweet peppers and fresh table grapes, falling within subheadings 07.01 S and ex 08.04 A I of the Common Customs Tariff, originating in Cyprus.

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community, and in particular Article 113 thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Whereas by Council Regulations (EEC) Nos. 3498/82 (1) and 806/83 (2) the Community has opened Community tariff quotas at reduced duty rates for 250 tonnes of sweet peppers and 7 000 tonnes of fresh table grapes, falling within subheadings 07.01 S and ex 08.04 A I of the Common Customs Tariff, originating in Cyprus; whereas Council Regulation (EEC) No /83 laying down the arrangements applicable to trade with Cyprus (3) provides for an increase of the above-mentioned quota volumes; whereas Regulations (EEC) Nos. 3498/82 and 806/83 must therefore be amended accordingly,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

Article 1

Regulation (EEC) No. 3498/82 is hereby amended as follows :

1. In Article 1 (1) the volume is increased from 250 to 300 tonnes
2. In Article 2 (3) the volume is increased from 65 to 115 tonnes.

Article 2

Regulation (EEC) No 806/83 is hereby amended as follows :

1. In Article 1 (1) the volume is increased from 7 000 to 7 500 tonnes
2. In Article 2 (3) the volume is increased from 494 to 994 tonnes.

Article 3

This Regulation shall enter into force on the third day following that of its publication in the Official Journal of the European Communities.

It shall apply with effect from 1 July 1983.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable to all Member States.
