increasing the Community tariff quota opened by Regulation (EEC) No 964/78 for certain eels falling within subheading ex 03.01 A II of the Common Customs Tariff

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

- 1. By its Regulation (EEC) No 964/78 of 8 May 1978¹, the Council opened and allocated among the Member States for the period from 1/7/1978 to 30/6/1979 a Community tariff quota for certain eels, falling within subheading No ex 03.01 A II of the Common Customs Tariff, the initial total volume of which was fixed at 6 100 tonnes, based on estimates for the first six months of 1978.
- 2. The state of the market in eels and the quantities which need to be imported from third countries were again discussed at a meeting of the Economic Tariff Problems Group held on 28 February 1979. In this connection, it was noted that additional needs, according to the forecasts put forward by the Member States, have been set at about 1 300 tonnes up to 30/6/1979.
- 3. This supplementary quota of 1 300 tonnes is allocated to the Community reserve of 1 200 tonnes set up at the beginning of the quota period by the original Regulation.

Draft COUNCIL REGULATION (EEC)

increasing the Community tariff quota opened by Regulation (EEC) No 964/78 for certain eels falling within subheading ex 03.01 A II of the Common Customs

Tariff

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community, and in particular Article 28 thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Whereas by Regulation (EEC) No 964/78 of 8 May 1978 on the opening, allocation and administration of a Community tariff quota for certain eels falling within subheading ex 03.01 A II of the Common Customs Tariff (1 July 1978 – 30 June 1979)¹ the Council opened and allocated among the Member States a zero-duty Community tariff quota, the volume of which was fixed at 6 100 tonnes;

Whereas, on the basis of the most recent figures concerning this product for the present period, it would appear that 1300 tonnes of additional imports into the Community from third countries are required; whereas the quota should be increased by this amount in order to take account of requirements; whereas to safeguard the Community nature of the tariff quota in question, this additional volume should be allocated to the Community reserve set up by Article 2(2) of Regulation (EEC) No 964/78,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

Article 1

2

The Community tariff quota opened by Regulation (EEC) No 964/78 for certain eels falling within subheading ex 03.01 A II of the Common Customs Tariff shall be increased from 6 100 to 7 400 tonnes.

Article 2

The said increase of 1 300 tonnes shall be allocated to the Community reserve provided for in Article 2(2) of Regulation (EEC) No 964/78, which shall thus be increased from 1 200 to 2 500 tonnes.

Article 3

This Regulation shall enter into force on the seventh day following its publication in the Official Journal of the European Communities.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
