fixing the guide prices for the fishery products listed in Annex I (A) and (C) to Regulation (EEC) No 100/76 for the 1980 fishing year

The present regulation is intended to fix guidance prices for products listed in annex I, A and C of Regulation (EEC) No 100/76 on the common organization of the market in the fishery products sector for 1980. Article 9 of this regulation allows for the fixing of a guide price for each of the products which is established for each fishing season on the basis of the average price on the wholesale market or representative port during the three fishing seasons preceding the fixing of the price for a significant proportion of the Community output for a product of defined market characteristics.

The starting point in the price fixing procedure for 1980 has been the comparison of the mean of the prices set out below established during the period 1977/1979 (1979: six months) and that of the period 1976/1978, the latter having been the base for fixing the guide price for 1979.

The guide price proposed for 1980 takes into account the very volatile and sensitive market situation for fishery products. While landing prices stayed generally at a relatively high level at the beginning of the year, there has been a marked tendency for a lowering of prices in recent months, a tendency which exceeded the normal seasonal fall. The effects of the guide prices for 1980 on the level of withdrawal prices and the desired relation—ship of these prices with regard to the lowest prices on the Community market have been correspondingly taken into account with regard to this tendency.

Given this situation, it is proposed that the guide prices for herring, Mediterranean sardines and mackerel for 1979 be retained for 1980 and to allow for a certain small increase in guide price from 1-6%, according to species, for most of the other products.

At the same time, taking account of the development of the market for the Atlantic sardine, a reduction of 4% in the guide price is proposed. With regard to the anchovy, it is necessary to allow for a reduction of the guide price of 7.5% following a further diminution of 1979 market prices accompanied by substantial withdrawals.

In order to avoid certain anomalies which occurred on the 1979 market, it is necessary to take measures to adjust certain marketing norms, in particular those for redfish and anchovy. The Commission will shortly submit a proposal modifying its November 1976 proposals by virtue of Article 149 of the Treaty. These modified norms should enter into force at the same time as the guide prices.

fixing the guide prices for the fishery products listed in Annex I (A) and (C) to Regulation (EEC)No 100/76 for the 1980 fishing year

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community, Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 100/76 (1) of 19 January 1976 on the common organization of the market in fishery products, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 2903/78 (2), and in particular Article 9 (4) thereof;

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission;

Whereas Article 9 (1) of Regulation (EEC) No 100/76 provides that a guide price shall be fixed each year for each of the products listed in Annex I (A) and (C) to that Regulation at a level which will help to stabilize market prices without leading to the formation of structural surpluses within the Community;

Whereas the guide prices for the said products were fixed for the 1979 fishing year by Regulation (EEC) No 2904/79 (3);

Whereas the application of the criteria defined in Article 9 of Regulation (EEC) No 100/76 and set out above involves, for the 1980 fishing year, for some products an increase, and for other products a decrease in prices by comparison with those valid for the current fishing year; whereas in the . absence of certain information concerning price trends for each fishery product with given commercial specifications, consideration should be given to the relationship between the average weighted market prices recorded when the guide prices were fixed for the previous fishing year for these products, and the average weighted market prices now current;

Under Regulation (EEC) No 100/76 on the common organization of the market in fishery products, a guide price is to be fixed for each of the products listed in Annex II to the Regulation. It is to be fixed for a product with given commercial characteristics and based on the average of prices recorded on representative wholesale markets or in representative ports during the three fishing years immediately preceding the fixing of the price for a significant proportion of the Community output.

Examination of the development of prices for the products in question shows that for certain products the guide price should be increase and for the others it should be maintained for the 1980 fishing year.

Whereas the guide prices for the said products were fixed for the 1979 fishing year by Regulation (EEC) No 2905/78 (3);

Whereas given the data available at present concerning prices for the products in question, it is necessary to increase these prices for certain products and to maintain them for others for the 1980 fishing year

Under Regulation (EEC) No 100/76 on the common organization in fishery products, the intervention price for fresh or chilled sardines and anchovies is fixed and this intervention price can be fixed at a level of between 35 and 45% of the guide price according to the production characteristics and the character of the particular market for each product.

The present regulation is intended to fix the intervention price in conformity with the dispositions of Regulation (EEC) No 100/76.

The present proposal reflects the Council declaration relating to the level of these prices. The Council invites the Commission to take into consideration, at the submission of the proposal relating to intervention prices, the importance which is attached to the need for these prices to be near the upper limit of the bracket shown in Article 9, paragraph 3" (of R/2129/70 (AGRI 691) of 20 October 1970).

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 100/76 of 19 January 1976 on the common organisation of the market in fishery products (1), as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 2903/78 (2), and in particular Article 9 (4) thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Whereas Article 9 (1) of Regulation (EEC) No 100/76 provides that intervention prices should be fixed for fresh or chilled sardines and anchovies at a level, which will help to stabilize market prices without leading to the formation of structural surpluses in the Community;

Whereas Article 9 (3) of the same Regulation provides that the intervention price should be fixed at a level between 35% and 45% of the guide price depending on the production and marketing characteristics peculiar to each product;

Whereas the guide prices for fishery products listed in Annex I (A) and (C) to Regulation (EEC) No 100/76 have been fixed for the 1980 fishing year by Regulation (EEC) No /79 (3);

Whereas given the present state of information on the market situation for the products in question and the absence of any experience in relation to purchases on the open market of these products, the intervention prices should be fixed at a level such as to ensure maximum support of the market,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Under Regulation (EEC) No 100/76 on the common organization of the market in fishery products, a community production price for tunny intended for canning is fixed, and this price can be fixed for a product defined by its market characteristics on the base of the mean of the wholesale market, prices or in the representative ports during the three fishing seasons preceding the fixing of this price and for a significant part of the Community production.

It is proposed to make a slight increase in price for the 1980 fishing year.

Whereas, on the basis of the criteria defined in Article 16(4) of Regulation (EEC) No 100/76, the price for the 1980 fishing year should be increased slightly,
